Though requirements will vary by class, it's always a good idea to have a single subject notebook for each class you have scheduled. If you select a different color for each class and use a supply of folders, also color coded to match the single subject notebook color, you can organize homework / assignments by color and subject. It would also be recommended to get a 3-ring binder to keep all of them in, plus a supply of loose leaf paper, along with an assortment of pens and pencils.
